## **Club Policy - Changing and Showering**

Changing facilities in the various Leagues our Adult teams play in make it difficult, if not impossible, to guarantee separate changing facilities for Adults and Children. As this will mean that Children sharing changing and shower facilities with Adults, this policy is intended to define a best practice and guidance to be adopted by the club.

- Parents and Children must be made aware of the club's Changing and Showering Policy.
- Mobile Phones, Photographic and Video Equipment must NOT be used in the changing Rooms.
- No Children should be left alone with an Adult in the changing Rooms.
- Where possible and practical, Adults should try to change at separate times to children during matches and training.
- Where possible and practical, Adults must not shower at the same time as Children. As there is a need for Children to change with Adults, consent must be obtained from the Parents of the Children playing Adult Cricket.
- If Children are uncomfortable changing or showering at the club, no pressure should be placed on them to do so. The Club suggest they change and shower at home.
- Where necessary, arrangements must be made for separate female changing.
