TRANSPORT TO AND FROM MATCHES POLICY

The Club has adopted a Transport Policy, in accordance with FA guidelines.

Travelling to away games should be both fun and safe. It should be a chance for all children to grow in confidence, self-esteem, and skills.

In signing the Junior Membership form, Parents and Guardians have given permission for children to participate in all competitions and away fixtures / events.

- In the first instance it is not the responsibility of the Coach / Team Manager to transport, or arrange to transport Children to and from the Club or match.
- If the Parent or Guardian cannot provide transport for their Child they should seek the assistance of another relative or parent.
- The Club strongly recommends that Parents / Guardians check with their motor insurance providers that they have insurance cover for the transportation of Children to football matches.
- The club Code of Conduct must be adhered to at all times.
- Coaches or managers may on occasion be asked to transport children when circumstances arise where the risk of not transporting the child is greater than doing so.
- If a manager/coach has to transport a child in their car, they must as far as possible adhere to the following points:
 - Inform the CWO of the journey
 - Have an enhanced DBS disclosure through the club
 - Have a roadworthy and appropriately insured vehicle
 - Have permission from the young player's parents
 - Where possible have another adult with them
 - Player(s) to be seated in the back of the vehicle wearing a seatbelt
- The club can take no responsibility for accidents which may happen whilst members are travelling in other parents or Committee member's vehicles.
